Subsea Vehicle Acoustic Receiver System



RJE has announced the release of a small and rugged "acoustic receiver" that is used to assist the operators of ROVs and AUVs in tracking underwater acoustic sound sources. Rated to a depth of 6,000m, its small size and separate hydrophones allow for flexible mounting to any subsea vehicle.

NEMO-V Submersible Data Relay for Autonomous Vehicles

The Nemo-V from Xeos Technologies is a bidirectional data relay beacon which is designed to send data and commands to a marine vehicle or platform. Submersible to 7,500m, the Nemo-V has RS-232 communication port that is built in to easily interact with any device connected. While at the surface, the GPS acquires its position and passes the coordination into the vehicle over RS-232 or over the Iridium network to the end user.
